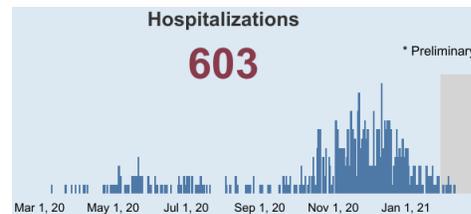

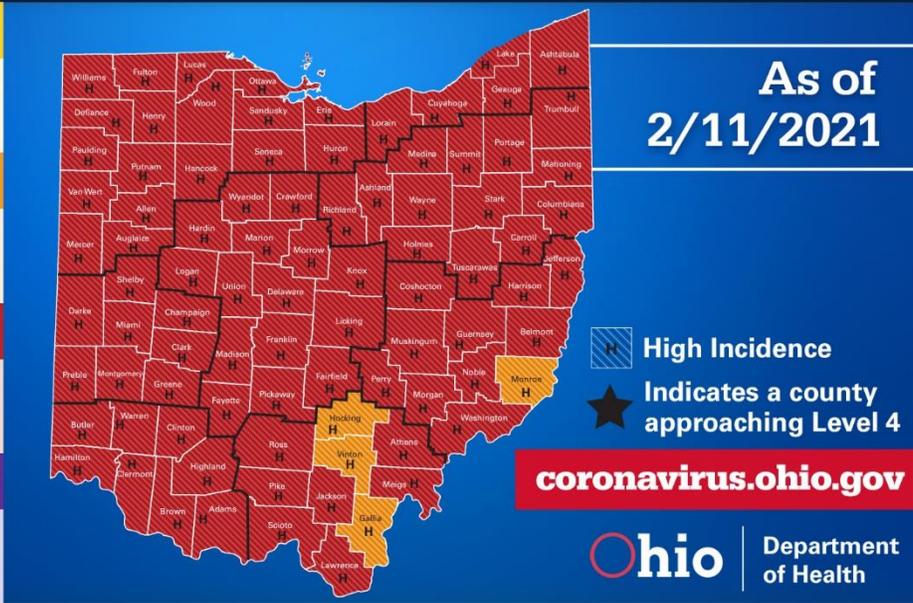

# Ohio Public Health Advisory System

<b>LEVEL 1</b>
<b>Public Emergency</b> Active exposure and spread.
<b>LEVEL 2</b>
<b>Public Emergency</b> Increased exposure and spread.
<b>LEVEL 3</b>
<b>Public Emergency</b> Very high exposure and spread.
<b>LEVEL 4</b>
<b>Public Emergency</b> Severe exposure and spread.



## Tuscarawas County: (announced by ODH on 2/11/2021)

**LEVEL 3**

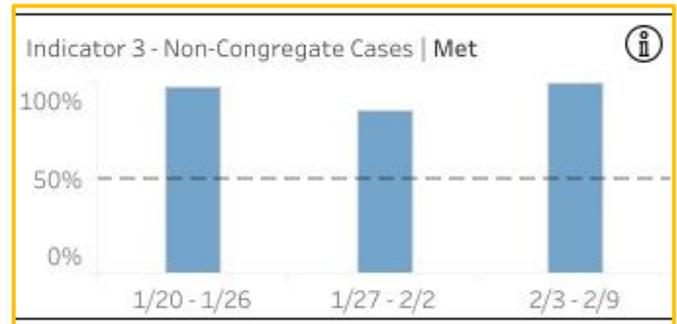
On 2/11/2021, Tuscarawas County remained at a Risk Level 3/Red county in the Ohio Public Health Advisory System. To be classified a Risk Level 3, 4 to 5 of the 7 data indicators must be met, OR if previously at Level 3, a county stays at Level 3 until it drops below the high incidence case threshold. Tuscarawas County meets the two indicators circled below:

<b>1.</b> 50 cases/ 100,000 Most Recent 2-weeks	<b>2.</b> New Cases Trajectory increase over a 5 day period	<b>3.</b> Proportion in Non- Congregate Settings (LTC)	<b>4.</b> COVID-like ED Trajectory increase over a 5 day period	<b>5.</b> COVID-like OP Trajectory increase over a 5 day period	<b>6.</b> Hospitalization Trajectory increase over a 5 day period	<b>7.</b> >80% threshold for capacity + 20% COVID ICU
