## **FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR**

**The last year has been one of change for the Tuscarawas County Health Department. We have closed our home health agency that was in operation for 20 years. Medicare guidelines, competition in this field and economic factors contributed to this decision.**

**We have extended our Dental program by employing a full-time Dentist, Dr. Michael H. Fomich. This has enabled us to broaden our dental services including root canals, caps and dentures.**

**Our clinic has employed a new physician, Dr. Anne Harper, M.D., Internal Medicine. She is now employed part-time but has indicated her intentions of full-time employment in May or June, 1998.**

**Physicians on staff at the Health Department also include, Dr. Phillip Doughten, M.D., Dr. Daniel S. Blumer, D.O., Dr. Umesh N. Betkerur, M.D., and Dr. Marcel N. Nwizu, M.D.**

**We feel our physicians are the finest available in the medical field and we sincerely appreciate and welcome them to our staff.**

**The Tuscarawas County Health Department has been proven to be a viable intermediary health care facility for the citizens of Tuscarawas County regardless of their economic levels.**
