
GENERAL HEALTH EDUCATION

SAFE BEGINNINGS

Abigale and Abbie provided the following equipment totaling \$1,173.10;

- Smoke and carbon monoxide alarms (3)

This equipment was distributed to six (6) TANF eligible families who also received safety-specific education in both verbal and in-person settings.

SAFE COMMUNITIES


