





ACCREDITATION

- Emma has started to heavily work on accreditation documents for reaccreditation. This will allow Natasha to just quickly review the documents that Emma has completed. Upon receiving reaccreditation, Emma will be taking over as the Accreditation Coordinator with Natasha providing direct oversight.
- Emma continued to gather documents and work on measures for reaccreditation.

CARSEATS

- Abigale and Abbie distributed 13 convertibles and 8 high back boosters in August. .
- Abigale and Abbie completed two car seat checks at TCHD in August.
- TCHD received a shipment of 28 convertibles and 4 high back boosters.

CRIBS FOR KIDS

- Abigale and Abbie provided safe sleep education and cribettes to 13 families throughout the month of August.
- Abigale ordered 10 English and 10 Spanish cribettes in August.
- TCHD received 30 cribettes in August from ODH and Stark County Health Department.
- Abigale is coordinating a safe sleep presentation for the upcoming parenting group at Tuscarawas County JFS.

DIAPER BANK

- In August, 27 new families were served from the diapers from the Heart of Ohio Diaper Bank. 5 families returned from June to receive services.
- In August, 2,878 items from the diaper bank were provided. This includes diapers, pull-ups, swimmers, wipes, and period packs.
- Abigale picked up the partner distribution for the month of September on August 22nd
- In conjunction with WIC, Abigale coordinated sending diaper bank supplies to the Dennison Clinic monthly to provide services to clients closer to their homes.

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

- On 8/1, Emma and Natasha met with NPCHD to conduct a facilitated discussion regarding their COOP.
- On 8/3, Emma and Natasha completed the Integrated Preparedness Plan Workshop.
- On 8/24 Emma and Natasha attended the monthly NECO region meeting virtually.
- Deliverable 15.1 (IS-244b training) was approved on 8/9/23. Deliverable 2.1 (COOP Facilitated Discussion), 3.1 (RAPT Training), 3.2 (Whole Community Planning), 6.1 (Performance Measures), 8.1 (IPPW Attendance), and 13.1 (Communications) were all submitted on 8/23/23. Deliverable 7.1 (AAR/IP Implementation Activity) was submitted on 8/29/23.

GENERAL HEALTH EDUCATION


- Emma facilitated a Bingocize session at the Tuscarawas County Senior Center
- Abigale began preparing materials and coordinating potential dates for the Community Baby Shower in Spring 2024.
- Health Ed received educational booklets on Perinatal Depression/ Maternal Mental Health and will begin distributing booklets with program education.
- TCHD was awarded two new ODH grants: Child Injury Prevention and Older Adult Falls Prevention.

NACCHO

• Emma, Lakyn, and Natasha received the Strategic Plan Report and SPACECAT site report from the NACCHO grant consultants.

PROJECT DAWN

- During August 2023, TCHD distributed 143 Naloxone kits, trained 141 individuals, and had 16 known reversals.
- Lakyn attended the Addiction Task Force meeting on August 24th.
- Lakyn facilitated a naloxone training for The Bluffs on August 14th.
- Lakyn presented a naloxone training to Ross School of Nursing students on August 18th.
- Harrison County Health Department, Carroll County Health Department, and Legacy Church were added as distribution partners.



SAFE BEGINNINGS

- TCHD received funding through the Ohio Children's Trust Fund to implement the Safe Beginnings program through FY2024.
- Abigale provided education and served 17 clients Safe Beginnings equipment in August totaling \$3,676.93. Items included: cribs, mattresses, toddler beds, baby video monitors, baby gates, child proofing kits, fire extinguishers, and more.

SAFE COMMUNITIES

- Click It or Ticket, Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over, Stay Alive Don't Text & Drive, and Look Out For Motorcycle materials were distributed in August.
 2 Spanish Click It or Ticket banners were distributed to the Hispanic group Puentes.
 1 CIOT and 1 DSOGPO banner were distributed to New Towne Mall.
- On August 16th the last coalition and fatal crash review meeting was held.
 - On August 28th, Abbie had a radio interview with WBTC.
- In August, Safe Communities attended 4 events: Touch a Truck, Second Saturday, DSOGPO kick off, and Tuscarawas Valley Farmers Market

TOBACCO

- Katelyn and Lakyn held the Tobacco and Vaping Committee meeting on the 8th. They reviewed the health equity strategic plan that the committee will be working on for the next 3 years.
- Katelyn and Lakyn attended all ODH required meetings for the grant on media and community outreach and engagement activities.
- Katelyn attended the Tobacco Free Ohio Alliance and OSU joint research showcase on the 22nd.
- The 2023 Community Survey on Tobacco was launched August 1st.

TRAFFIC SAFETY

- In August, there were a total of 116 accidents.
- In August, the most crashes occur during the 4-4:59pm hour and the most crashes occur on Wednesdays.
- As of August 31st, there have been two (2) fatal crashes in Tuscarawas County in 2023.
