Communicable Disease

- 4 COVID-19/Flu A/B Tests administered (-6)
 - 25% positivity for COVID-19 (-5%)
 - 0% positivity for Flu A/B (0%)
- Top reported diseases in November 2024:
 - COVID-19: 47(-21)
 - Chlamydia: 17 (+8)
 - Lyme: 4 (-3)
 - Total Confirmed Reported Diseases: 92 (+2)

Prevention

- Distributed 94 Naloxone kits (+4)
 - 6 known reversals (+4)
- 10 car seats distributed (-13)
- Safe sleep education completed with 15 families (-5)
- 16 NEW families served at TCHD in November (-4)

WIC

- 84% show rate for November (-2%)
- 452 total appointments completed (-87)

Environmental Health

- 4 complaints investigated (-8)
 - 1 Food Service
 - 3 Solid Waste (2 contained septic concerns as well)

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Medical Clinic

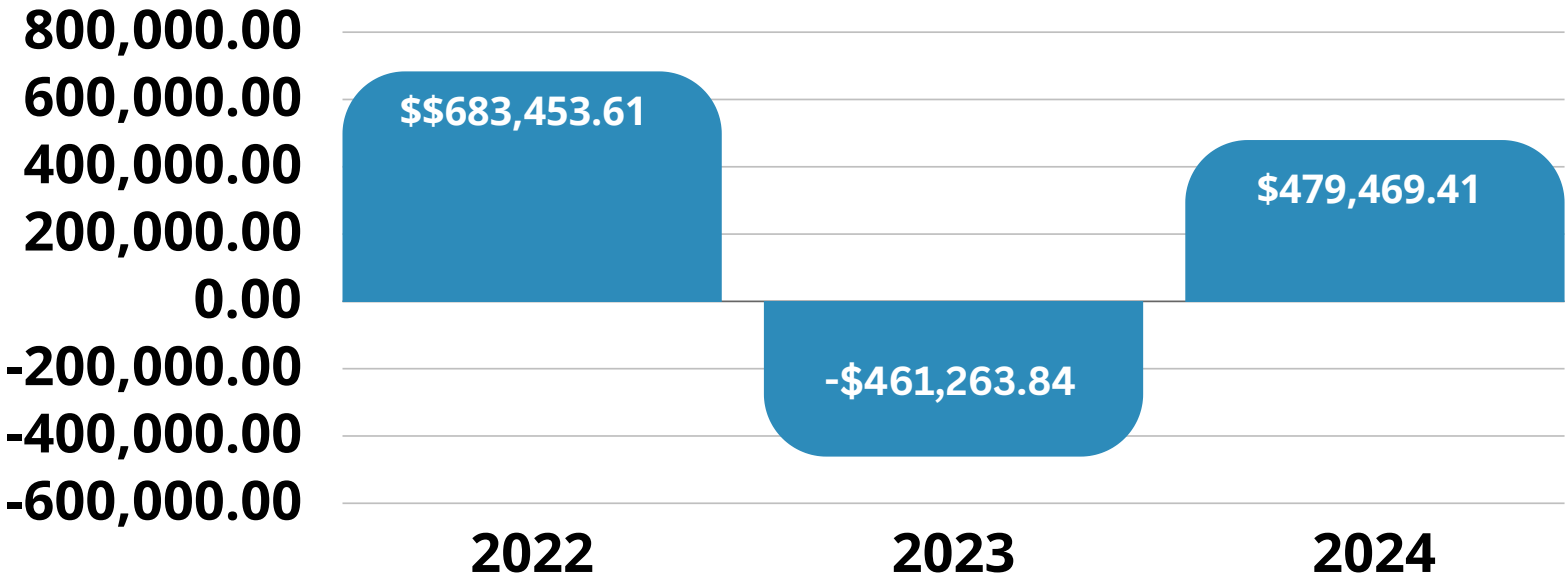
- Charges in November \$55,442 (12-month average \$69,279)
- Payments in November \$50,273 (12-month average \$42,865)
- Largest payer Commercial Insurance (36%)
- 18% no-show rate (+9%)
- 10 new patients in November (144 YTD)
- Current Outstanding Balance \$82,748.64; greater than 90 days \$22,544.85
