Department Highlights



Communicable Disease

- 19 COVID-19/Flu A/B Tests administered (53% positivity for COVID-19; 0% positivity for Flu A/B)
- Top reported diseases in October 2023:
 - COVID-19: 194 (+113)
 - Chlamydia: 10 (0)
 - Lyme: 2 (-5)
 - Salmonella (2) (+2)
 - Total Confirmed Reported Diseases: 120 (+37)

Prevention

- Distributed 118 Naloxone kits (-25)
 - 5 known reversals (-9)
- 20 car seats distributed (-1)
- Safe sleep education completed with 13 families (0)
- Traffic Safety YTD Statistics:
 - Total YTD crashes investigated: 1,531 (-94 from 2022)
 - Total YTD fatalities: 2 (-5 from 2022)
 - Total crashes investigated in September 2023: 146 (-19)
 - Most crashes occurred between 2:00-2:59pm and 3:00-3:59pm (12.3%) and on Friday (17%)
 - Top crash routes: IR-77 (13%), SR-39 (11%), and SR-416 (10%)
 - Top crash variables: Youth Related (38%), Unbelted (24%), Failure to Yield (14%), and Deer Related (14%)

- 73% show rate in September (-9%)
- 401 total appointments completed (-143)
