## Medical Office

- Charges in December \$45,375 (12-month average \$55,463)
- Payments in December \$30,161 (12-month average \$27,028)
- Largest payer: Commercial Insurance (21%)
- 19% no-show rate (+6%)
- 13 new patients in December (173 YTD)
- Current Outstanding Balance \$128,320.77; greater than 90 days \$50,116.11 (Medicaid makes up 44%)

## Promotion and Community Relations

Here are the highlights for December 2025:

- **Trending Topics:** flu vaccines; new TCHD main entrance and construction changes; holiday food safety; and winter safety (heating, driving, cold weather, & etc.)
- **Paid Promotional Campaigns:** ADAMHS Board partner ads for Senior Medication Safety/naloxone, tobacco cessation digital ads, Winter Emergency Preparedness radio commercials, and WTUZ EH radio show discussing waste management and recycling

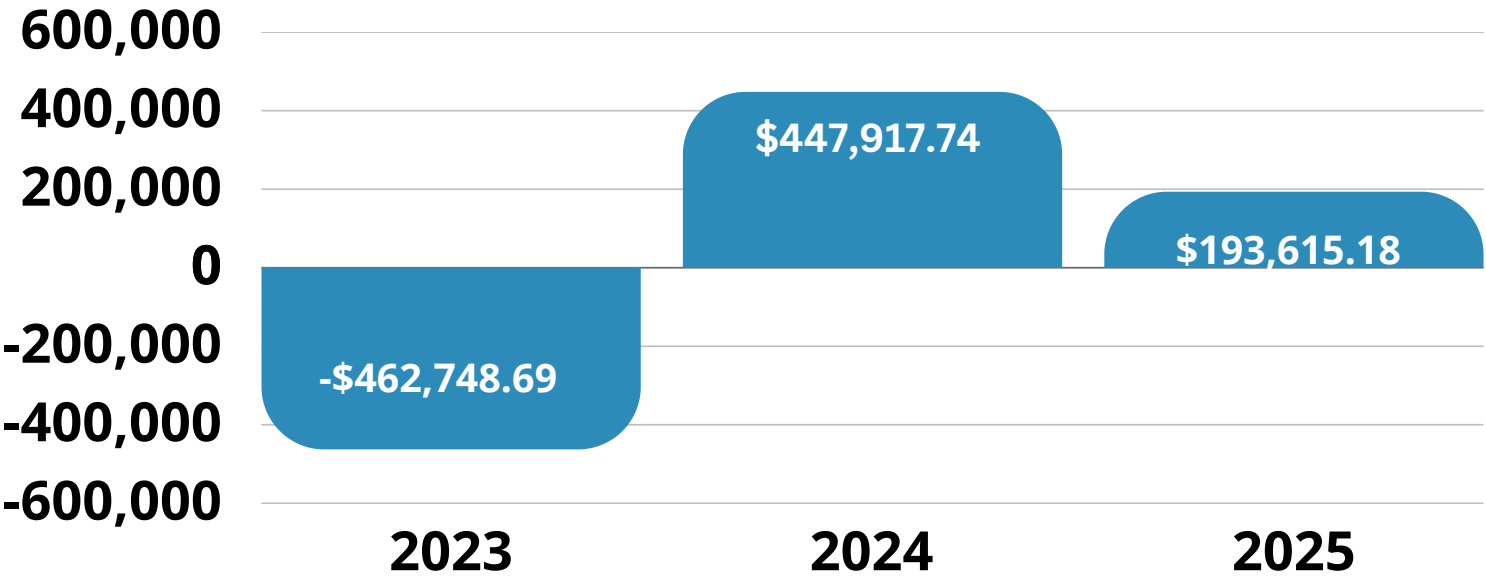
