

Department Highlights



Communicable Disease

- Administered 5 (-21) rapid influenza (flu) tests
 - 0 positive Influenza A (0% positivity)
 - 0 positive Influenza B (0% positivity)
- Administered 5 (-27) COVID-19 Tests
 - 2 PCR tests (0/2 Positive)
 - 5 Rapid Tests (0/5 Positive)
- Top reported diseases in April 2023:
 - COVID-19:129 (-131)
 - Chlamydia: 11 (+1)
 - Pertussis: 8 (+6)
 - Total Confirmed Reported Diseases: 157 (-46)

Prevention

- Distributed 52 Naloxone kits (-81)
 - 9 known reversals (-1)
- 20 car seats distributed (+9)
- Safe sleep education completed with 6 families (-1)
- Traffic Safety YTD Statistics:
 - Total YTD crashes investigated: 697 (-35 from 2022)
 - Total YTD fatalities: 1 (-1 from 2022)
 - Total crashes investigated in April 2023: 143 (-431 from March)
 - Most crashes occurred between 4:00-5:59pm (19.6%) and on Monday and Thursday (35%)
 - Top crash routes: SR-39 (17%), IR-77 (8%), and SR-800 (7%)
 - Top crash variables: Youth Related (37%), Unbelted (30%), Failure to Yield (17%)

- Administered 16 COVID-19 vaccines (-6)
- Charges \$55,225 (12 month average \$64,140)
- Payments \$19,856 (12 month average \$33,346)
- Largest Payer for April Cash(27%)
- No shows 58 (7.46% compared to 9.63% last month)

WIC

- 123 total contacts for breastfeeding support (-7)
- 69% show rate in April (+2%)
- 454 total appointments completed (+35)


