Communicable Disease

- **Top reported diseases for July (excluding COVID-19):**
 - **Chlamydia 11 (+2)**
 - **Chronic Hepatitis C 8 (+5)**
 - **Gonorrhea 3 (+1)**

Prevention

- **Distributed 49 Naloxone kits (-22). 10 recorded known reversals (+1)**
- **20 car seats distributed (+1)**
- **Safe sleep education completed with 12 families (+1)**
- **Traffic Safety YTD (August 8, 2022) Statistics:**
 - **Total crashes investigated: 722 (-25 from 2021)**
 - **Enforcement stops: 3,338 (+244 from 2021)**
 - **YTD traffic fatalities: 6 (0 change from 2021)**

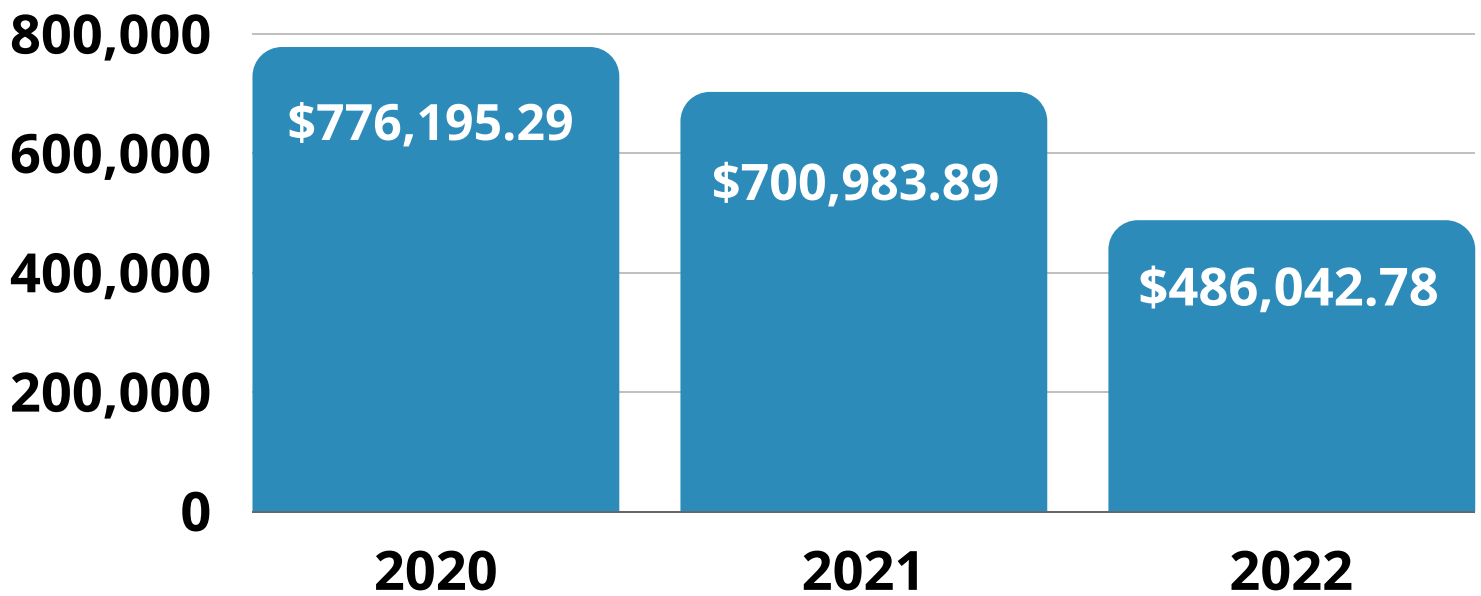

COVID-19

- **680 cases in July (+349)**
- **COVID-19 vaccines administered: 168 (-9)**
- **Administered 30 COVID-19 PCR (+14); 18 positive results (60% positivity; increased by 29%)**
- **160 Antigen tests (+94); 50 positive results (31% positivity; increased by 19%)**
