Department Highlights



Communicable Disease

- Administered 26 (+1) rapid influenza (flu) tests
 - 0 positive Influenza A (0% positivity)
 - 0 positive Influenza B (0% positivity)
- Administered 32 (+7) COVID-19 Tests
 - 6 PCR tests (0/6 Positive)
 - 26 Rapid Tests (10/26 Positive, 38%)
- Top reported diseases in March 2023:
 - COVID-19 260 (+47)
 - Chlamydia 10 (-8)
 - Gonorrhea 4 (+2)
 - Total Confirmed Reported Diseases 203 (+35)

Prevention

- Distributed133 Naloxone kits (+111)
 - 10 known reversals (+3)
- 11 car seats distributed (-4)
- Safe sleep education completed with 7 families (-4)
- Traffic Safety YTD Statistics:
 - Total YTD crashes investigated: 520 (-35 from 2022)
 - Total YTD fatalities: 1 (-1 from 2022)
 - Total crashes investigated in March 2023: 159 (+51 from Feb)
 - Most crashes occurred between 2:00-2:59pm (11.3%) and on Wednesday (22%)
 - Top crash routes: SR-39 (9%) and SR-416 (8.8%)
 - Top crash variables: Youth Related (35%), Deer Related (22%), Unbelted (19%)


- Administered 22 COVID-19 vaccines (-8)

- Largest Payer for March 2023 Medicaid (23%)
- No shows 89 (9.63% compared to 10.17% last month)

- 130 total contacts for breastfeeding support (+24)
- 67% show rate in March (-12%) returned to in-person appointments
- 419 total appointments completed (-35)
