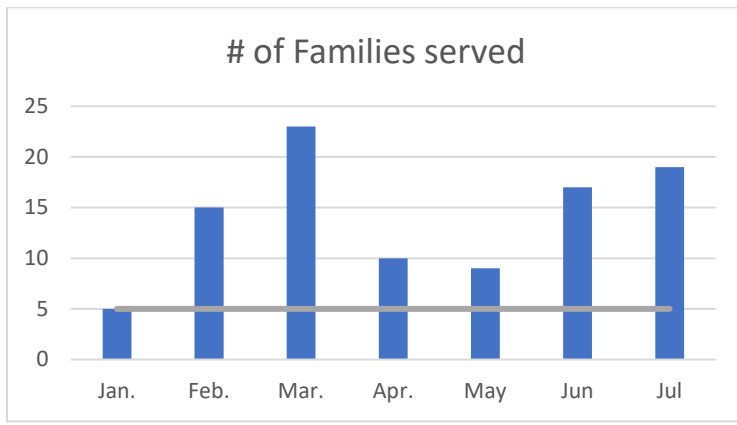

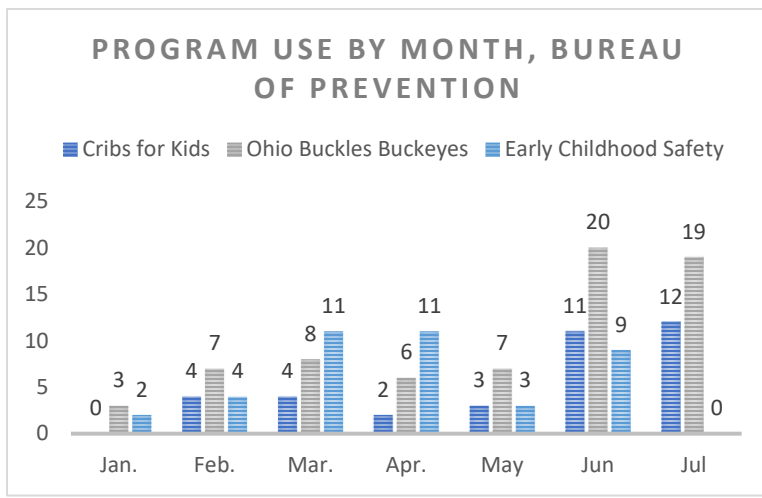

Received notice that TCHD was awarded \$4,000 for a mini-grant for Falls Prevention. The grant will start in October 2022.

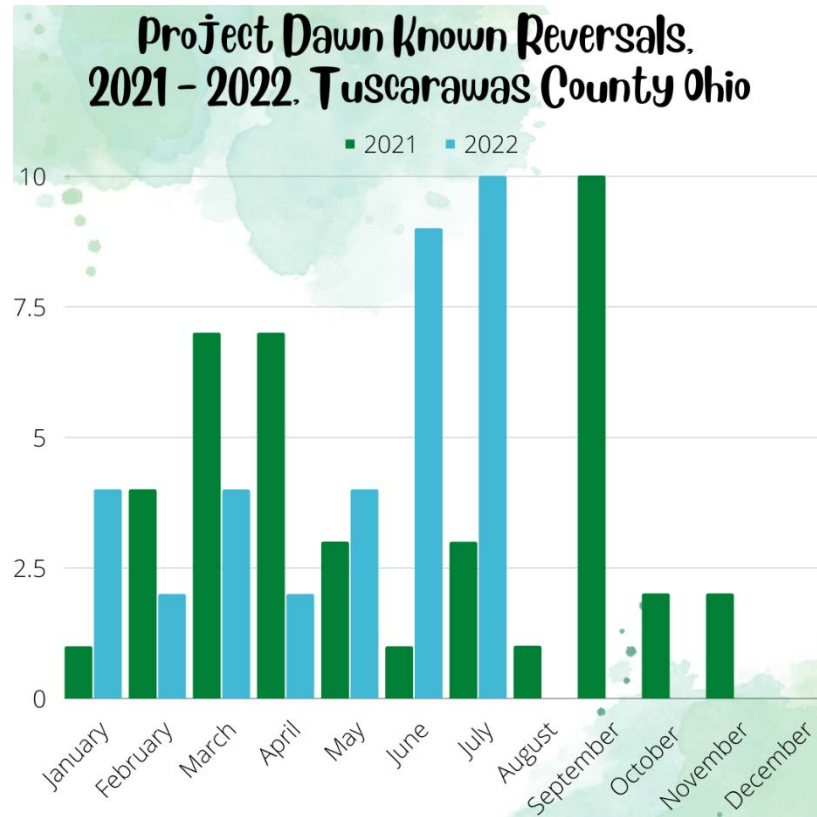
Health education is spending time planning for a lot of the upcoming events in August and September. Fair booth preparation has commenced.

Project Dawn:

During July 2022, TCHD distributed 49 Naloxone kits, trained 45 people, and 10 known reversals. That is a decrease of 39% of kits distributed June to July 2022.

Autumn presented at Vertava Health, and Katelyn attended to observe.



Safe Beginnings:

Abigale completed end of year reporting for Safe Beginnings for the grant period ending June 30th. Safe Beginnings served a total of forty-five (45) families from November 2021 through July 2022.

Natasha and Abbie attended the virtual Motorcycle Safety Committee meeting presented by the Ohio State Highway Patrol on July 12th. The meeting discussed upcoming construction zones, and motorcycle crashes and trends throughout District 7.

Safe Communities staff distributed 113 campaign materials to the Tuscarawas County citizens at various events throughout the month of July.

Tobacco:

The new grant began on July 1, 2022.

Autumn Poland and Katelyn Gorius attended all the Deliverable Document Webinars and Kick-off Trainings for the TU23 grant year.

The Tobacco staff also hosted the monthly Tobacco – Vaping Committee meeting where an educational discussion was held on Tobacco Retailer Licenses and how they are being implemented in other counties across Ohio.

Tobacco cessation resources, STAND stretchy bands, and educational vaping information was distributed at the Rivercrest Farm Event.

Traffic Safety:

As of July 31, 2022, there have been six (6) fatal crashes resulting in six (6) fatalities in Tuscarawas County. The image below illustrates all crashes in July 2022 in Tuscarawas County. In June, there were a total of 131 accidents, of which one (1) was fatal.
