Department Highlights



Communicable Disease

- Administered 29 rapid influenza (flu) tests (-61)
 - 0 positive Influenza A (0% positivity)
 - 0 positive Influenza B (0% positivity)
- Administered 29 COVID-19 Tests
 - 11 positive (38% positivity)
- Top reported diseases for January 2023:
 - COVID-19 225
 - Hospitalized Influenza 12 (all Influenza A)
 - Chlamydia 9
 - Total Reported Diseases 254

Prevention

- Distributed 55 Naloxone kits (+44)
 - 4 known reversals (+1)
- 14 car seats distributed (+7)
- Safe sleep education completed with 3 families (-2)
- Traffic Safety YTD Statistics:
 - Total crashes investigated: 176 (-22 from 2021)
 - Most crashes occurred between 6-6:59pm (10.8%) and on Wednesday (33)
 - Top crash routes: IR-77 (22), SR-39 (20), US-250 16)
 - Top crash variables: Speed Related (45), Unbelted (45), Youth Related (41)
 Deer Related (34)
 - 0 Fatalities (-2 from 2021)
