Communicable Disease

- 7 COVID-19/Flu A/B Tests administered (-1)
 - 0% positivity for COVID-19 (-25%)
 - 15% positivity for Flu A/B (+2%) - Flu A only
- Top reported diseases in January 2025:
 - COVID-19: 159 (-29)
 - Influenza A Hospitalized: 15
 - Chlamydia: 10 (+1)
 - Total Confirmed Reported Diseases: 175 (-34)

- Inspections conducted in January:
 - Food Inspections: 83

Medical Clinic

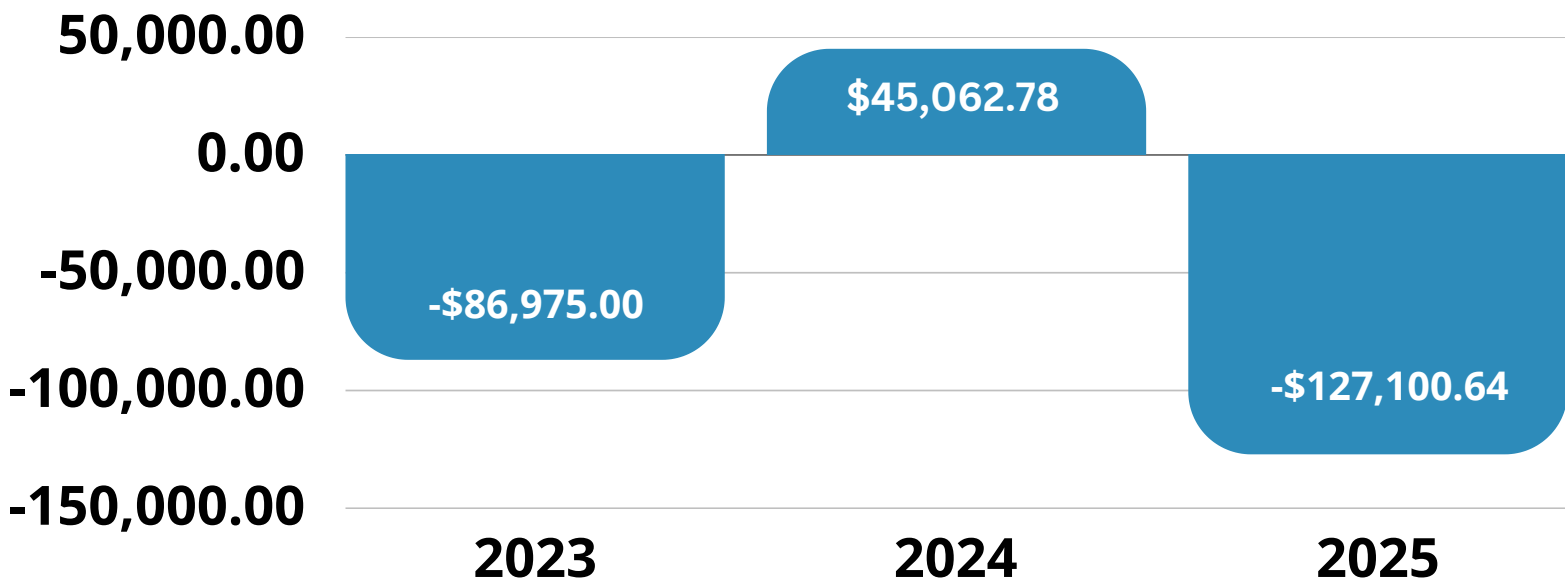
- Charges in January \$45,437 (12-month average \$63,999)

- 9 new patients in January (9 YTD)
- Current Outstanding Balance \$55,906.05; greater than 90 days \$24,706.25
