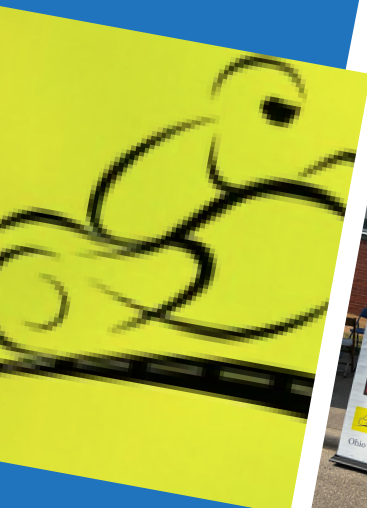

#### 10 Early Signs & Symptoms of Alzheimer's

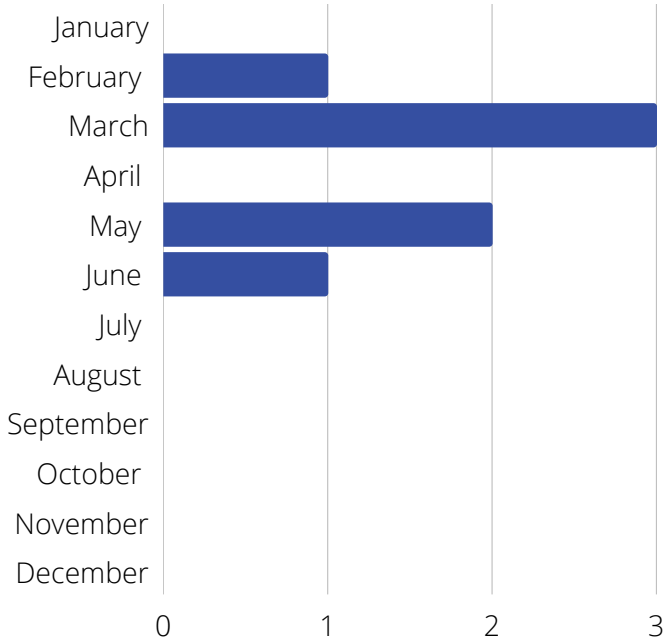
1	Memory loss that disrupts daily life	2	Challenges in problem solving

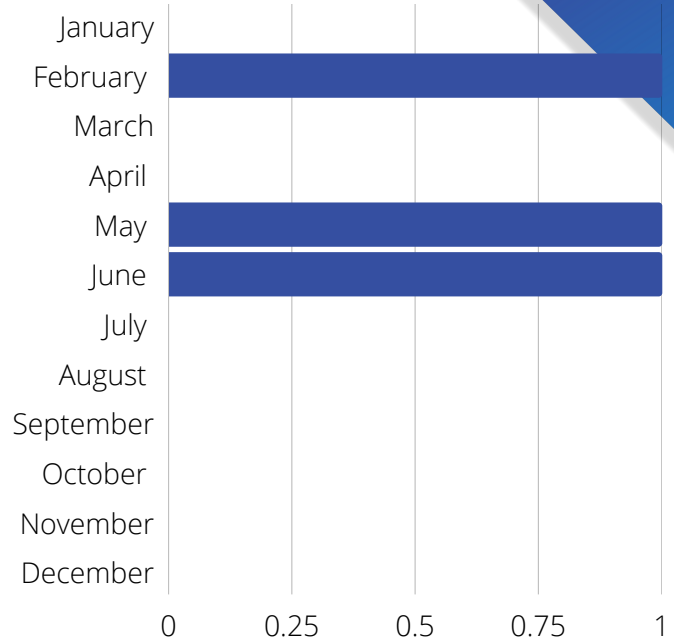

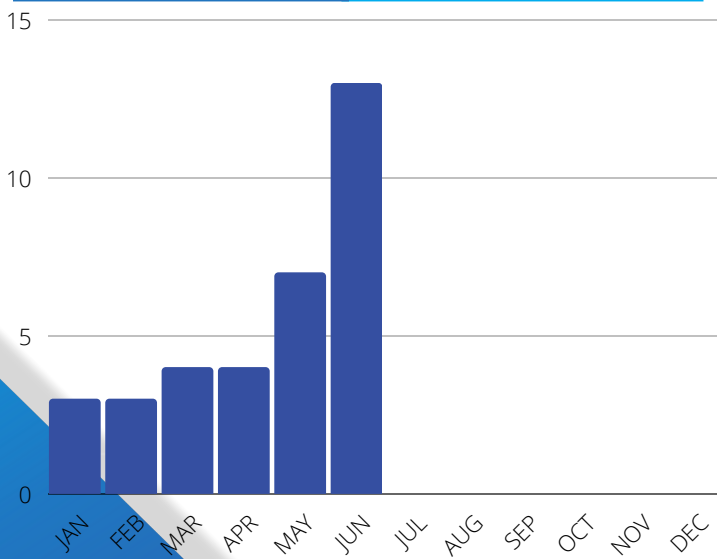

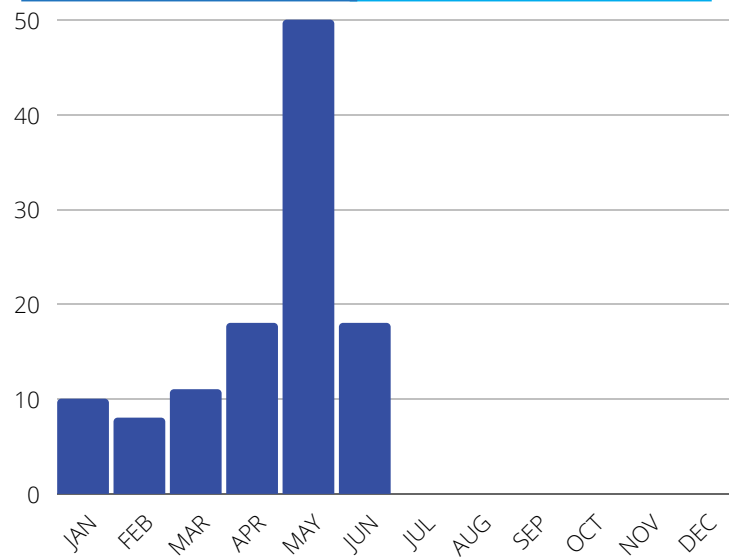

# ACCREDITATION

- Natasha and Chelsea attended on June 5-7 the virtual Public Health Improvement Training.
- Natasha has worked on updating the internal tracking document to reflect documents that are pending coversheet completion or final review. As of June 21st, TCHD has 34% of documents in the final stage.

# CARSEATS

- Abigale and Abbie distributed 8 convertibles in June.
- TCHD received a transfer of 7 convertibles from another county in the region.
- Abbie presented a car seat class at All About Children Daycare on June 27th.
- Abbie and Abigale did a car seat check event at All About Children Daycare on June 28th, where 5 seats were checked.

# CRIBS FOR KIDS

- Abigale and Abbie provided safe sleep education and cribettes to 7 families throughout the month of June.
- Abigale continued offering cribettes to WIC clients during extended office hours.

# DIAPER BANK

- In June, 14 new families were served from the diapers from the Heart of Ohio Diaper Bank. 5 families returned from May to receive services.
- In June, 796 items from the diaper bank were provided. This includes diapers, pull-ups, swimmers, wipes, and period packs.
- Abigale picked up the partner distribution for the month of July on June 27th.

# EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

- Natasha, Abigale, and Emma met with Tuscarawas County EMA on 6/26 to discuss the upcoming Statewide Exercise to be held in October and worked on planning locally.
- On 6/23, Natasha attended the LEPC Tabletop Exercise as an observer.
- Emma and Abigale continued to review current TCHD plans and update, as necessary.

## GENERAL HEALTH EDUCATION

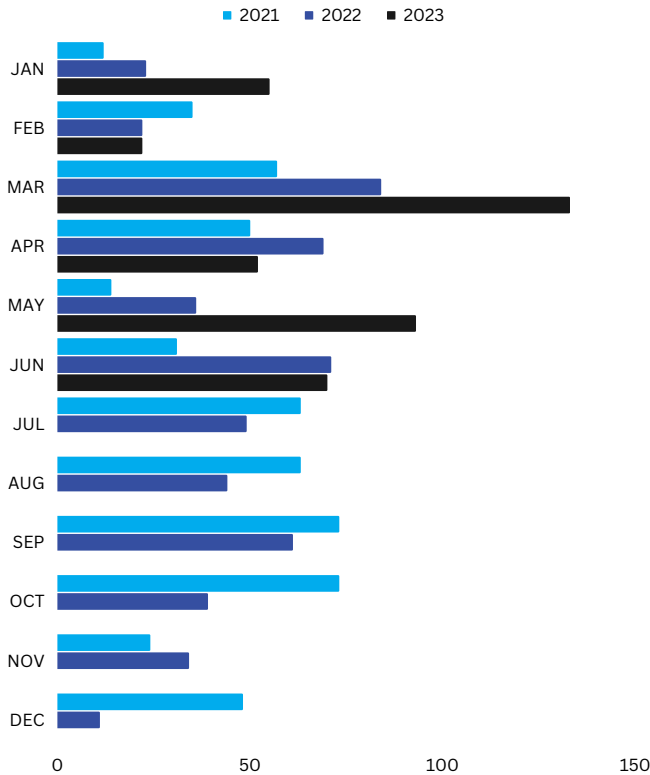
- Natasha and Katelyn attended the Healthy Tusc CHIP meeting on June 13th.

## PROJECT DAWN

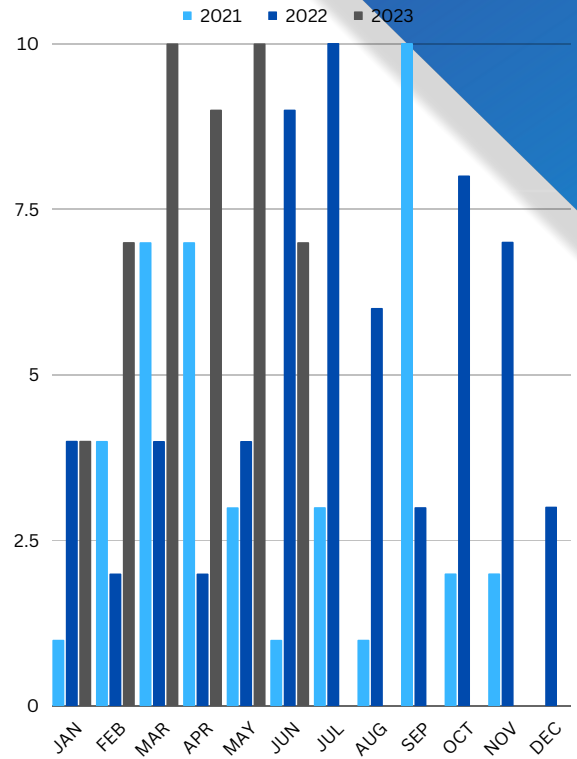
- During June 2023, TCHD distributed 70 Naloxone kits, trained 67 individuals, and had 7 known reversals.
- Lakyn and Katelyn facilitated the Project DAWN pop up event hosted at the Tuscarawas Valley Farmers Market on June 14th.
- Katelyn facilitated a naloxone training for The Bluffs on June 26th.
- There were 6 first responder naloxone kits distributed to the Dover Police Department.
- There has been a large increase in mail order naloxone kits since April when the request process was updated to an online format.

## SAFE COMMUNITIES

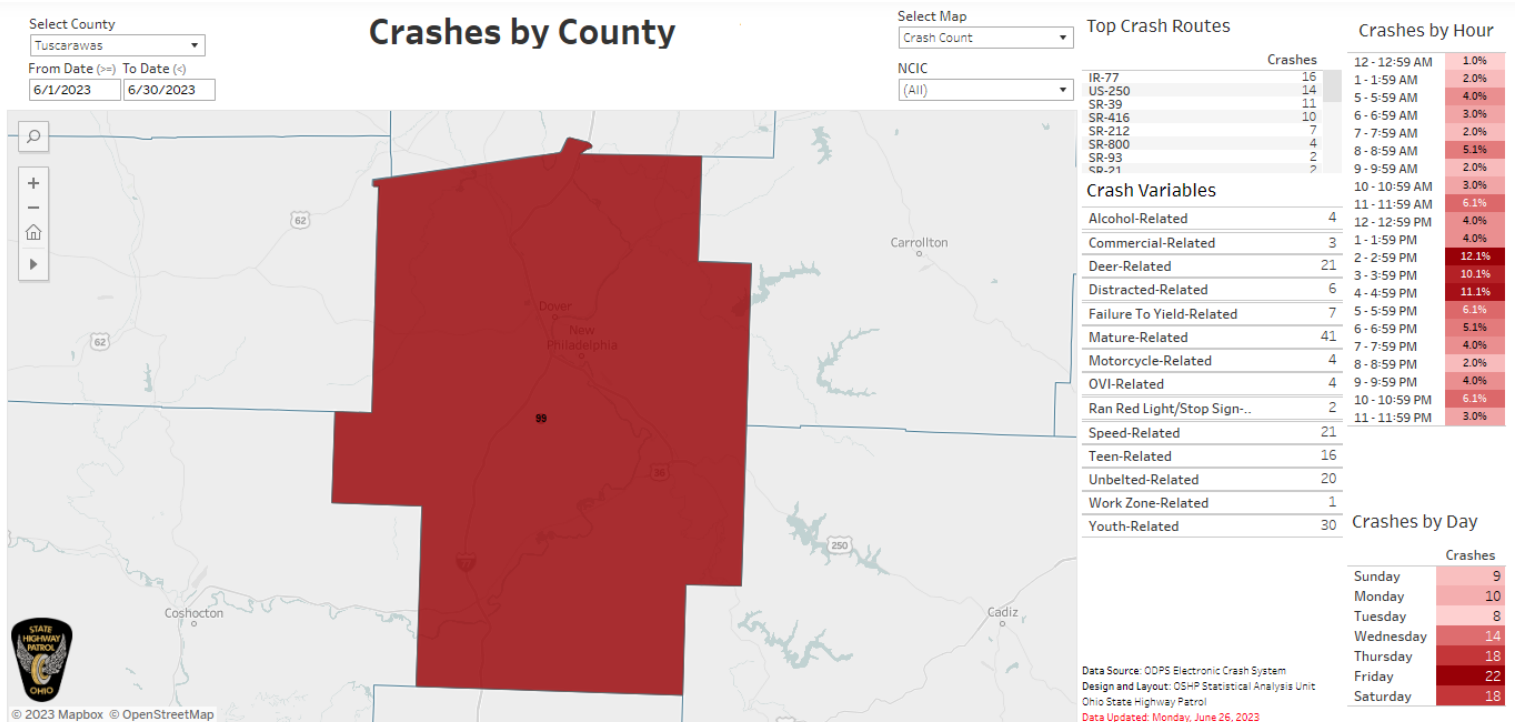

- On June 2nd, Safe Communities attended the Dennison Railroad Festival.

- On June 26th, Abbie had a bi-monthly radio interview with WBTC to discuss the 100 deadliest days of summer and safe driving tips.

# TOBACCO

- On June 7th, Katelyn attended the Center for Tobacco Independence's virtual conference on Health Equity: Strategies to Reduce Tobacco-Related Disparities.
- Katelyn and Lakyn worked with local community leaders to complete this year's Community Readiness Assessment survey.

# TRAFFIC SAFETY

- In June, there were a total of 99 accidents.
- In June, the most crashes occur during the 2-2:59pm hour and the most crashes occur on Fridays.
- As of June 30th, there have been one (1) fatal crashes in Tuscarawas County in 2023.
