## Medical Clinic

- Charges in May \$51,931 (12-month average \$61,557)
- Payments in May \$26,399 (12-month average \$35,124)
- Largest payer Medicaid (28%)
- 19% no-show rate (+1%)
- 21 new patients in May (62 YTD)  
Current Outstanding Balance \$63,300.62; greater than 90 days \$20,843.79

## Promotion and Community Relations

Here are the trending topics and other highlights for May 2025:

- Trending Topics: construction project; measles; Household Hazardous Waste event; Lyme disease awareness month/ticks; and Health & Wellness Fair Event.
- Paid Promotional Campaigns: Project DAWN, suicide prevention, back-to-school immunizations, household hazardous waste collection (paid for by Recycling District), and tobacco cessation campaigns
- Social Media Posts: 234 social media posts ran in May 2025 (152 on Facebook where our largest audience interacts, 59 on X/Twitter, and 23 on Instagram)

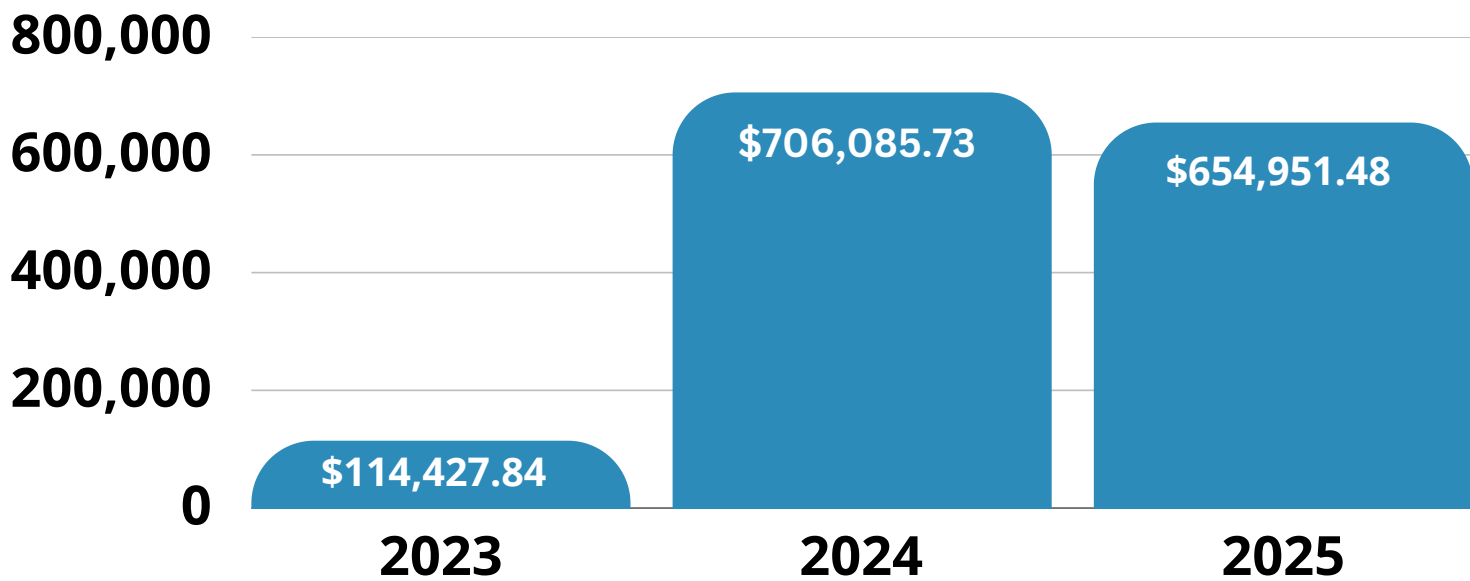
- 86% show rate for May (+6%)
