

Department Highlights



Communicable Disease

- Administered 6 (+1) COVID-19 Tests
 - 3 positive results
- Top reported diseases in May 2023:
 - COVID-19:129 (-131)
 - Chlamydia: 11 (+1)
 - Pertussis: 8 (+6)
 - Total Confirmed Reported Diseases: 157 (-46)

Prevention

- Distributed 93 Naloxone kits (+41)
 - 10 known reversals (+1)
- 23 car seats distributed (+3)
- Safe sleep education completed with 6 families (-1)
- Traffic Safety YTD Statistics:
 - Total YTD crashes investigated: 846 (-35 from 2022)
 - Total YTD fatalities: 1 (-1 from 2022)
 - Total crashes investigated in May 2023: 133 (-23 from April)
 - Most crashes occurred between 4:00-4:59pm (10.5%) and on Friday (21%)
 - Top crash routes: SR-39 (16%), IR-416 (10%), and IR-77 (10%)
 - Top crash variables: Youth Related (35%), Unbelted (28%), Deer Related (18%), Speed Related (18%)

- Administered 174 COVID-19 vaccines (+158)
- Charges \$55,225 (12 month average \$64,140)
- Payments \$19,856 (12 month average \$33,346)
- Largest Payer for May Cash (27%)
- No shows 58 (7.46% compared to 9.63% last month)

WIC

- 123 total contacts for breastfeeding support (-7)
- 69% show rate in April (+2%)
- 454 total appointments completed (+35)
