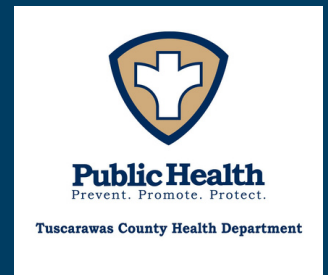
Communicable Disease

- Top reported diseases for May (excluding COVID-19):
 - Chlamydia 18 (+5)
 - Gonorrhea 3 (-1)
 - Chronic Hepatitis C 3 (+3)

Prevention

- Distributed 36 Naloxone kits (-33). 4 recorded known reversals (+2)
- 5 car seats distributed
- Safe sleep education completed with 2 families
- Traffic Safety YTD (May 31, 2022) Statistics:
 - Total crashes investigated: 515 (-2 from 2021)
 - Enforcement stops: 2,454 (+287 from 2021)
 - YTD traffic fatalities +3 from 2021

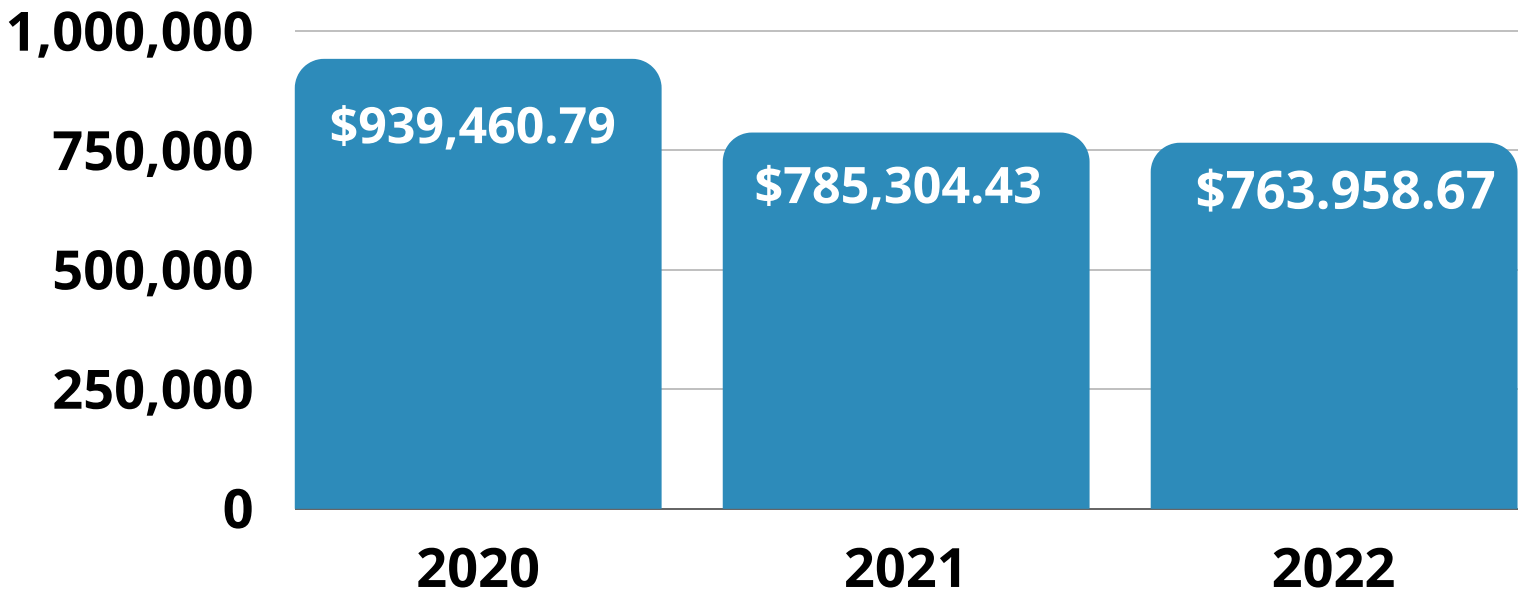

COVID-19

- 224 cases in May (+139)
- COVID-19 vaccines administered: 419 (-144)
- Administered 15 COVID-19 PCR (-4); 0 positive results (0% positivity)
- 98 Antigen tests (+48); 29 positive results (30% positivity; increase by 28%)
