Communicable Disease

- **Administered 54 rapid influenza (flu) tests**
 - 1 positive Influenza A (2% positivity)
 - 0 positive Influenza B (0% positivity, -2%)
- **Administered 161 influenza vaccines (-128)**
- **Top reported diseases for November (excluding COVID-19):**
 - Hospitalized Influenza A 17 (+16)
 - Chlamydia 9 (-8)
 - Gonorrhea 6 (+3)

Prevention

- **Distributed 34 Naloxone kits (-15)**
 - 7 known reversals (-1)
- **11 car seats distributed (-13)**
- **Safe sleep education completed with 6 families (+2)**
- **Traffic Safety YTD Statistics:**
 - Total crashes investigated: 2,133 (+37 from 2021)
 - Most crashes occurred between 3-4pm (8.3%)
 - Top crash routes: SR-39 (259), IR-77 (230), US-250 (1183)
 - Top crash variables: Youth-Related (665), Unbelted (539), Speed (414), Deer (411)
 - **YTD traffic fatalities: 9 (0 from 2021)**

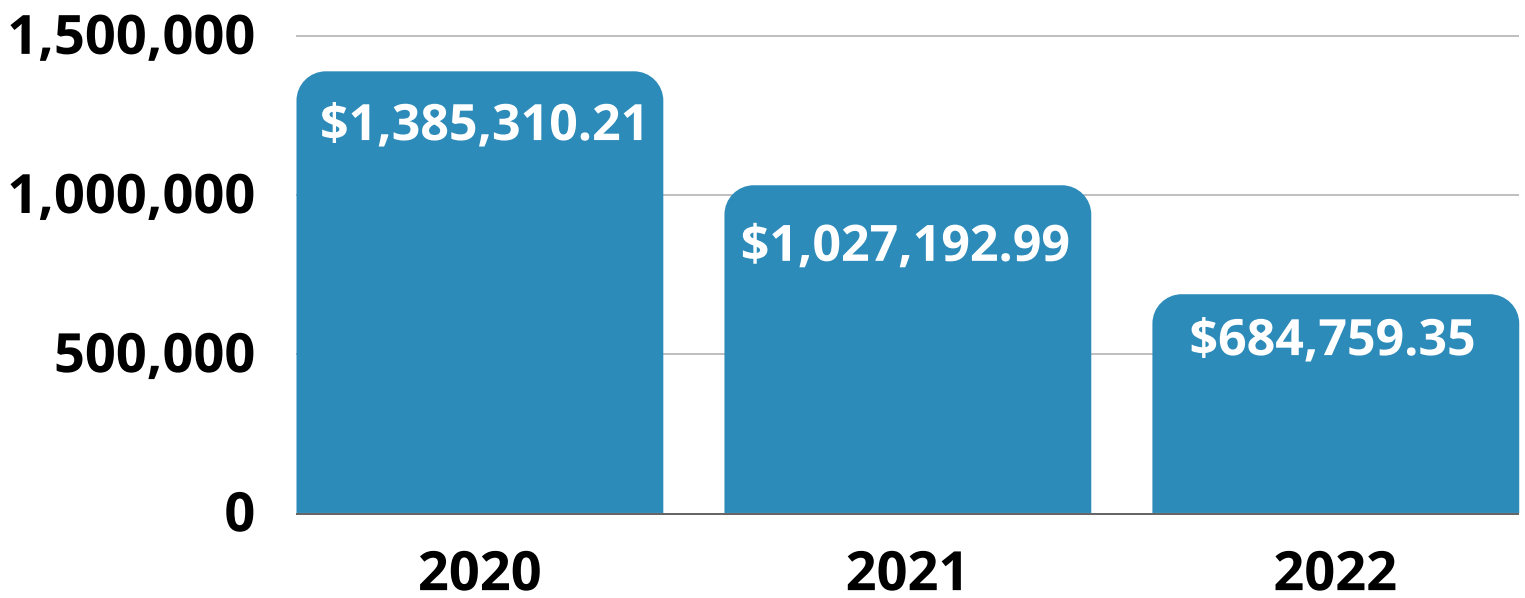

COVID-19

- **254 cases (+24)**
- **COVID-19 vaccines administered: 301 (-349)**
- **Administered 2 COVID-19 PCR (-7)**
 - 2 positive results (100% positivity; increased by 82%)
- **54 Antigen tests (-1)**
 - 14 positive results (26% positivity; decreased by 5%)
