## Communicable Disease

- **Administered 55 rapid influenza (flu) tests**
  - 1 positive Influenza A (2% positivity)
  - 1 positive Influenza B (2% positivity)
- **Administered 289 influenza vaccines**
- **Top reported diseases for October (excluding COVID-19):**
  - Chlamydia 17 (+8)
  - Gonorrhea 3 (+2)
  - Strep Pneumonia 3 (+3)

## Prevention

- **Distributed 49 Naloxone kits (-12)**
  - 8 known reversals (+5)
- **24 car seats distributed (+19)**
- **Safe sleep education completed with 4 families (+4)**
- **Traffic Safety YTD Statistics:**
  - Total crashes investigated: 1,824 (-93 from 2021)
    - Most crashes occurred between 3-4pm (8.3%)
    - Top crash routes: SR-39 (220), IR-77 (188), US-250 (157)
    - Top crash variables: Youth-Related (568), Unbelted (471), Speed (371), Deer (303)
  - **YTD traffic fatalities: 7 (-2 from 2021)**

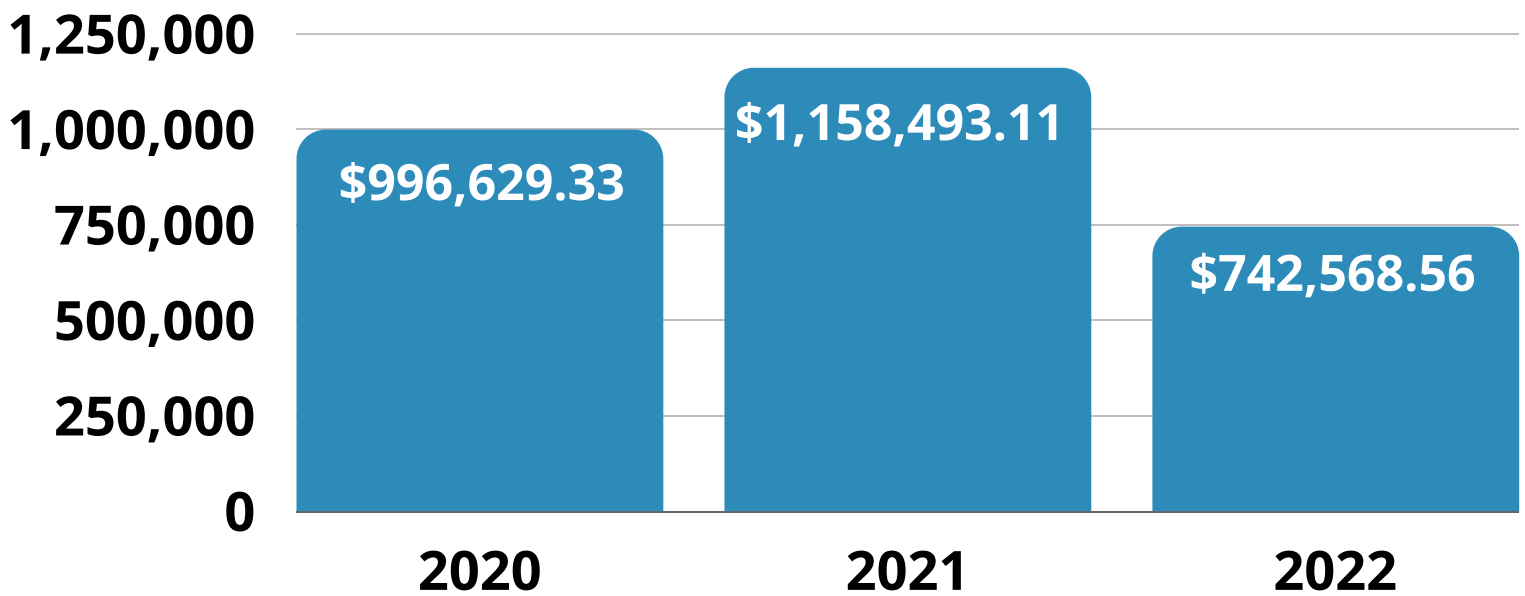

## COVID-19

- **230 cases (-232)**
- **COVID-19 vaccines administered: 650 (+310)**
- **Administered 9 COVID-19 PCR (-3)**
  - 2 positive results (22% positivity; decreased by 20%)
- **55 Antigen tests (-47)**
  - 17 positive results (31% positivity; decreased by 6%)
