Communicable Disease

- **Top reported diseases for September (excluding COVID-19):**
 - Chlamydia 9 (+5)
 - Chronic Hepatitis C 2 (+1)
 - Salmonella 2 (0)

Prevention

- Distributed 61 Naloxone kits (+17). 3 known reversals (-3)
- 5 car seats distributed (-10)
- Safe sleep education completed with 3 families (0)
- Traffic Safety YTD Statistics:
 - Total crashes investigated: 1,607 (-73 from 2021)
 - Most crashes occurred between 2-4pm
 - Top crash routes: SR-39 (200), IR-77 (158), US-250 (137)
 - Top crash variables: Unbelted (157), Failure to Yield (101), Youth-related (92)
 - YTD traffic fatalities: 7 (0 change from 2021)

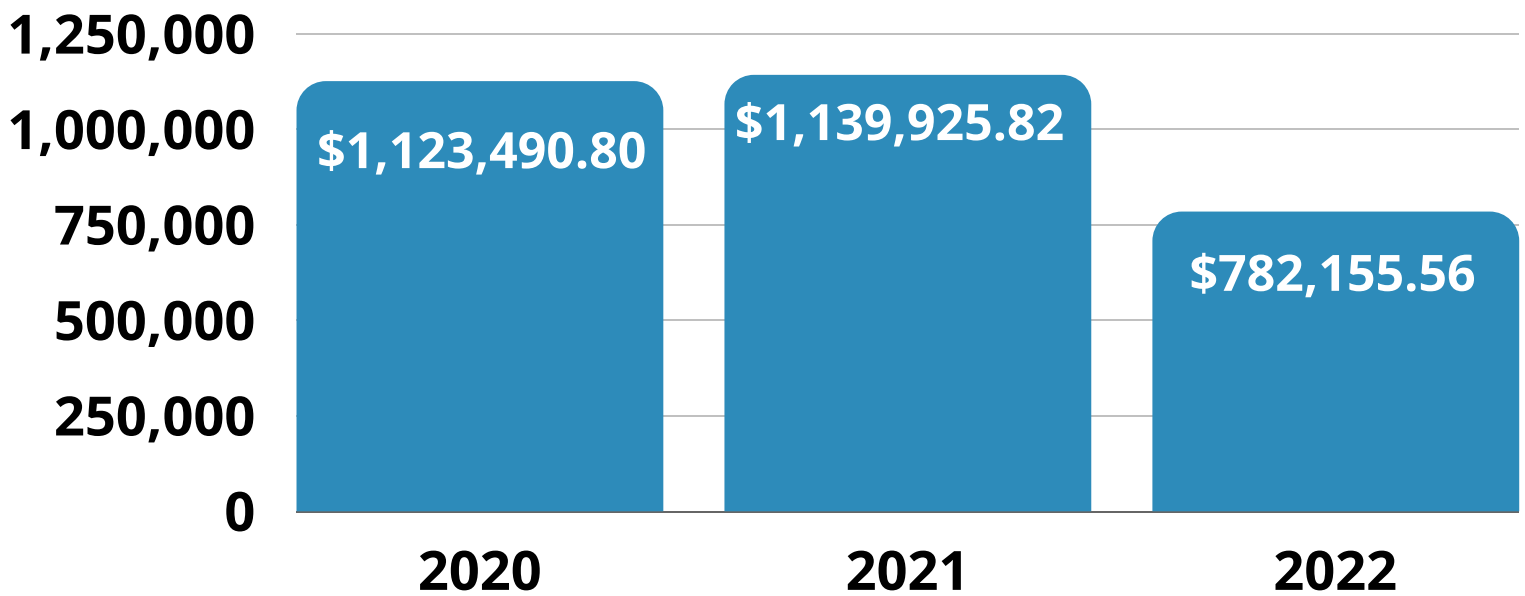

COVID-19

- 462 cases (-270)
- COVID-19 vaccines administered: 340 (+181)
- Administered 12 COVID-19 PCR (-9); 5 positive results (42% positivity; decreased by 15%)
- 102 Antigen tests (-114); 38 positive results (37% positivity; decreased by 6%)
