Medical Office

- Charges in September \$47,875 (12-month average \$57,610)
- Payments in September \$28,852 (12-month average \$31,513)
- Largest payer Commercial Insurance (26%)
- 17% no-show rate (+3%)
- 15 new patients in September (119 YTD)
- Current Outstanding Balance \$91,154.62; greater than 90 days \$27,141.30.

Promotion and Community Relations

Here are the highlights for September 2025:

- Trending Topics: county fair; flu vaccines; COVID-19 vaccines; whooping cough; public health vending machine
- Paid Promotional Campaigns: Project DAWN, WIC, CHC, ADAMHS Board partner ads for Senior Medication Safety/naloxone, and WTUZ food safety radio show

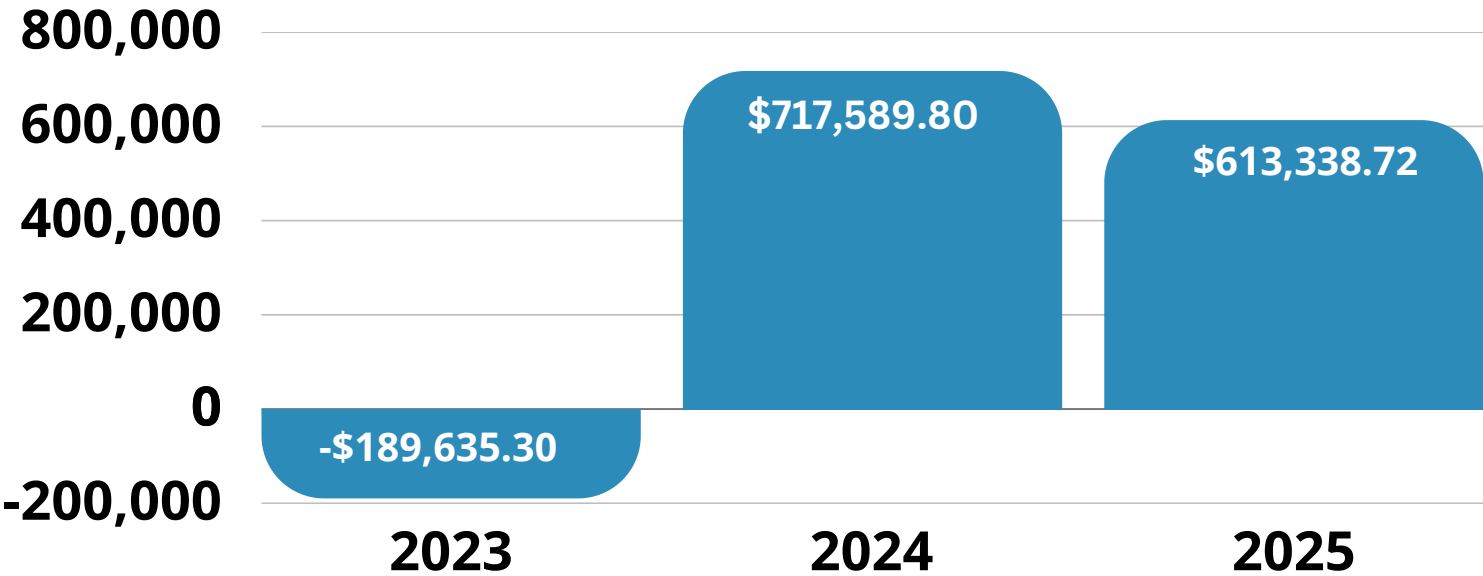
