Ohio (As of August 4, 2022)

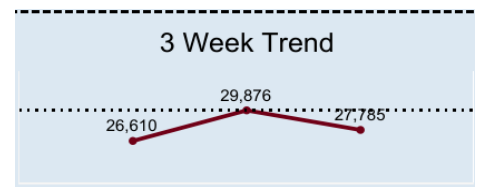
