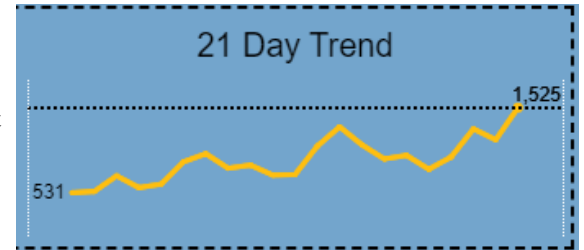

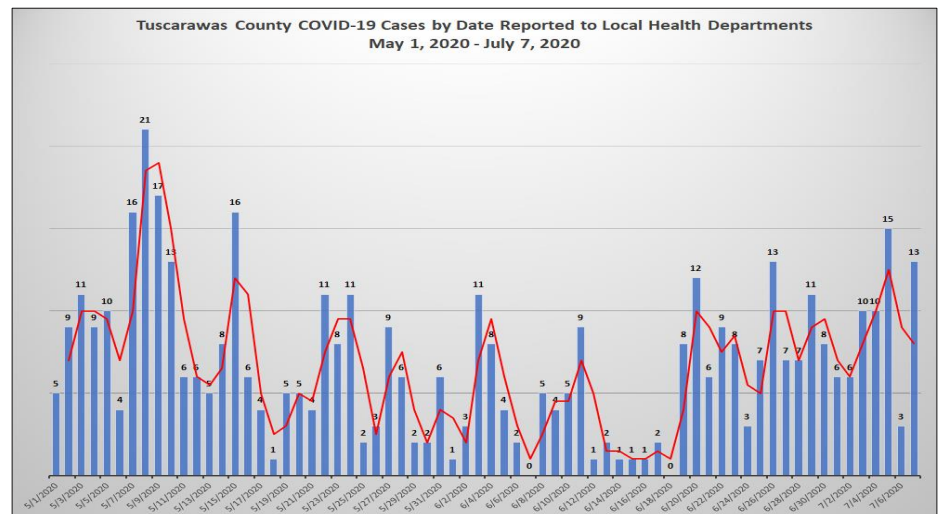

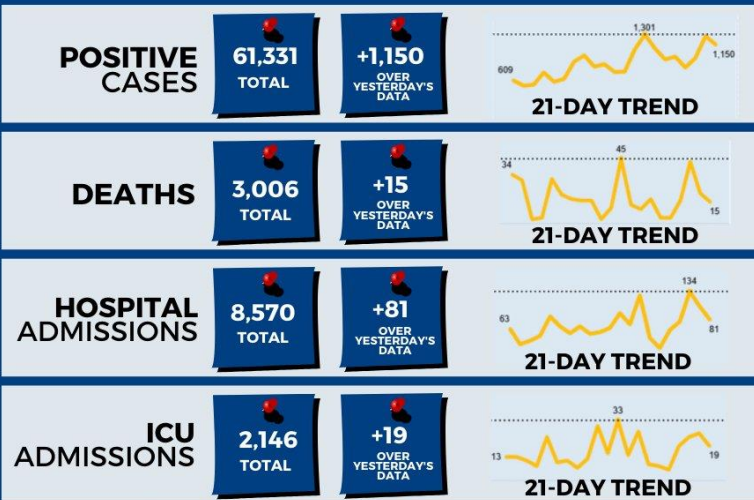
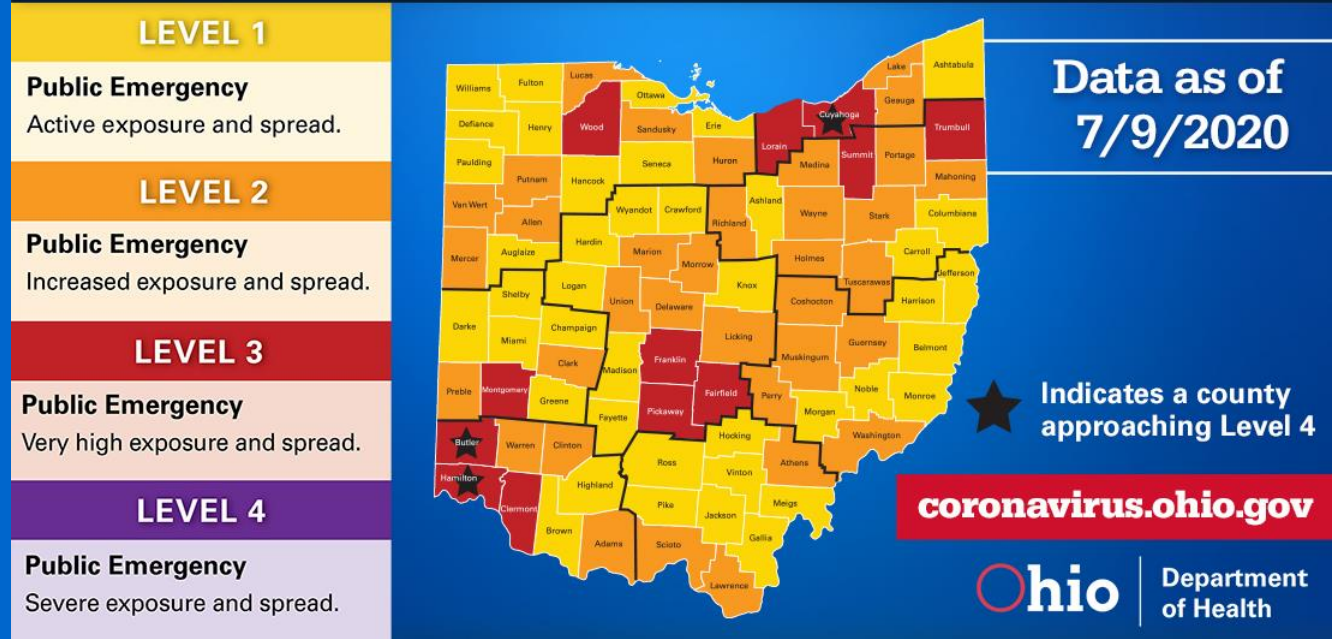
# NEW RISK LEVEL MAP:

12 counties have triggered enough indicators to be at Red Alert Level 3. Three of those counties are on the watch list, meaning they are close to reaching Level 4: Butler, Cuyahoga, Hamilton. Franklin Co. dropped off the watch list. Huron Co. is now a Level 2.
